1 On page 4, after line 28, insert the following:

2 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 5.** A new section is added to chapter 18.27 RCW
3 to read as follows:

4 (1) A contractor commits a violation under this chapter and is
5 subject to an infraction if, on a single job site, the contractor works
6 on a task that is performed together by:

7 (a) More than two sole proprietor contractors, at least one of
8 which has no workers subject to coverage of Title 51 RCW on that job
9 site;

10 (b) More than one contractor other than a sole proprietorship, at
11 least one of which has no workers subject to coverage of Title 51 RCW
12 on that job site.

13 (2) If contractors are working in the same trade or craft on a
14 single job site, the contractors have the burden of proof to show that
15 they are not working together on the same task.

16 (3) The violation is committed by all contractors who are parties
17 to the contract for performance of that task.

18 (4) For purposes of this section, "job site" means a single
19 physical address, or multiple addresses if the addresses are covered by
20 the same general contract."

21 On page 1, line 3 of the title, after "adding" strike "a new
22 section" and insert "new sections"

EFFECT: An infraction occurs if, on a single job site, a contractor works on a task that is performed together by more than two sole proprietor contractors or more than one contractor other than a sole proprietor, when at least one of the contractors has no covered workers. If the contractors are working together in the same trade or craft, the contractors have the burden of proof to show that they are not working together on the same task. A "job site" is a single physical address, or multiple addresses if the addresses are covered by the same general contract. The violation is committed by all contractors who are parties to the contract for the performance of that task.
