- 1 AN ACT Relating to verification that applicants for drivers'
- 2 licenses and identicards are lawfully within the United States;
- 3 amending RCW 46.20.035; and adding a new section to chapter 46.20 RCW.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.20.035 and 2008 c 267 s 8 are each amended to read 6 as follows:
  - The department may not issue an identicard or a Washington state driver's license that is valid for identification purposes unless the applicant meets the identification requirements of subsection (1), (2),
- 10 or (3) of this section <u>and the identification requirements of</u> 11 subsection (4) of this section.
- 12 (1) A driver's license or identicard applicant must provide the 13 department with at least one of the following pieces of valid 14 identifying documentation that contains the signature and a photograph 15 of the applicant:
- 16 (a) A valid or recently expired driver's license or instruction 17 permit that includes the date of birth of the applicant;
- 18 (b) A Washington state identicard or an identification card issued 19 by another state;

- (c) An identification card issued by the United States, a state, or an agency of either the United States or a state, of a kind commonly used to identify the members or employees of the government agency;
  - (d) A military identification card;
  - (e) A United States passport; or

- (f) ((An Immigration and Naturalization Service)) A citizenship and immigration services form.
- (2) An applicant who is a minor may establish identity by providing an affidavit of the applicant's parent or guardian. The parent or guardian must accompany the minor and display or provide:
- (a) At least one piece of documentation in subsection (1) of this section establishing the identity of the parent or guardian; and
- (b) Additional documentation establishing the relationship between the parent or quardian and the applicant.
- (3) A person unable to provide identifying documentation as specified in subsection (1) or (2) of this section may request that the department review other available documentation in order to ascertain identity. The department may waive the requirement if it finds that other documentation clearly establishes the identity of the applicant. Notwithstanding the requirements in subsection (2) of this section, the department shall issue an identicard to an applicant for whom it receives documentation pursuant to RCW 74.13.283.
- (4) A driver's license or identicard applicant must provide the department with documentation that the applicant is a United States citizen or that the applicant's presence in the United States is authorized under federal law.
- (5) An identicard or a driver's license that includes a photograph that has been renewed by mail or by electronic commerce is valid for identification purposes if the applicant met the identification requirements of subsection (1), (2), or (3) of this section at the time of previous issuance.
- $((\frac{5}{}))$  (6) The form of an applicant's name, as established under this section, is the person's name of record for the purposes of this chapter.
- ((<del>(6)</del>)) <u>(7)</u> If the applicant is unable to prove his or her identity under this section <u>or provide the documentation required under</u> subsection (4) of this section, the department shall plainly label the license "not valid for identification purposes."

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 46.20 RCW to read as follows:

The department may adopt rules to establish procedures for: (1) Verifying that a driver's license or identicard applicant is a United States citizen or that the applicant's presence in the United States is authorized under federal law, including appropriate documentation of that status; and (2) appeals hearings from denials and cancellations of drivers' licenses or identicards based on the requirement that a licensee or identicard holder be a United States citizen or be lawfully within the United States.
