1 AN ACT Relating to hit and run provisions; amending RCW 46.52.020;
2 and reenacting and amending RCW 9.94A.515.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.52.020 and 2002 c 194 s 1 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 (1) A driver of any vehicle involved in an accident (~~resulting in~~
7 ~~the injury to or death of any person or~~) involving striking the body
8 of a deceased person shall immediately stop such vehicle at the scene
9 of such accident or as close thereto as possible but shall then
10 forthwith return to, and in every event remain at, the scene of such
11 accident until he or she has fulfilled the requirements of subsection
12 ~~((+3))~~ (5) of this section; every such stop shall be made without
13 obstructing traffic more than is necessary.

14 (2) A driver of any vehicle involved in an accident resulting in
15 the death of a pedestrian, bicyclist, or motorcyclist shall immediately
16 stop such vehicle at the scene of such accident or as close thereto as
17 possible but shall then forthwith return to, and in every event remain
18 at, the scene of such accident until he or she has fulfilled the
19 requirements of subsection (5) of this section.

1 (3) A driver of any vehicle involved in an accident resulting in
2 the injury of a pedestrian, bicyclist, or motorcyclist shall
3 immediately stop such vehicle at the scene of such accident or as close
4 thereto as possible but shall then forthwith return to, and in every
5 event remain at, the scene of such accident until he or she has
6 fulfilled the requirements of subsection (5) of this section.

7 (4)(a) The driver of any vehicle involved in an accident resulting
8 only in damage to a vehicle which is driven or attended by any person
9 or damage to other property must move the vehicle as soon as possible
10 off the roadway or freeway main lanes, shoulders, medians, and adjacent
11 areas to a location on an exit ramp shoulder, the frontage road, the
12 nearest suitable cross street, or other suitable location. The driver
13 shall remain at the suitable location until he or she has fulfilled the
14 requirements of subsection ~~((+3+))~~ (5) of this section. Moving the
15 vehicle in no way affects fault for an accident.

16 (b) A law enforcement officer or representative of the department
17 of transportation may cause a motor vehicle, cargo, or debris to be
18 moved from the roadway; and neither the department of transportation
19 representative, nor anyone acting under the direction of the officer or
20 the department of transportation representative is liable for damage to
21 the motor vehicle, cargo, or debris caused by reasonable efforts of
22 removal.

23 ~~((+3+))~~ (5) Unless otherwise provided in subsection ~~((+7+))~~ (9) of
24 this section the driver of any vehicle involved in an accident
25 resulting in injury to or death of any person, or involving striking
26 the body of a deceased person, or resulting in damage to any vehicle
27 which is driven or attended by any person or damage to other property
28 shall (a) give his or her name, address, insurance company, insurance
29 policy number, and vehicle license number and shall exhibit his or her
30 vehicle driver's license to any person struck or injured or the driver
31 or any occupant of, or any person attending, any such vehicle collided
32 with ~~((and shall))~~, (b) render to any person injured in such accident
33 reasonable assistance, including the carrying or the making of
34 arrangements for the carrying of such person to a physician or hospital
35 for medical treatment if it is apparent that such treatment is
36 necessary or if such carrying is requested by the injured person or on
37 his or her behalf, and (c) contact law enforcement or emergency

1 personnel. Under no circumstances shall the rendering of assistance or
2 other compliance with the provisions of this subsection be evidence of
3 the liability of any driver for such accident.

4 ~~((4))~~ (6)(a) Any driver covered by the provisions of subsections
5 (1) through (3) of this section failing to stop or comply with any of
6 the requirements of subsection ~~((3))~~ (5) of this section in the case
7 of an accident resulting in death is guilty of a class B felony and,
8 upon conviction, is punishable according to chapter 9A.20 RCW.

9 (b) Any driver covered by the provisions of subsections ~~((1))~~ (2)
10 and (3) of this section failing to stop or comply with any of the
11 requirements of subsection ~~((3))~~ (5) of this section in the case of
12 an accident resulting in injury is guilty of a class C felony and, upon
13 conviction, is punishable according to chapter 9A.20 RCW.

14 (c) Any driver covered by the provisions of subsections (1) through
15 (3) of this section failing to stop or comply with any of the
16 requirements of subsection ~~((3))~~ (5) of this section in the case of
17 an accident involving striking the body of a deceased person is guilty
18 of a gross misdemeanor.

19 (d) This subsection shall not apply to any person injured or
20 incapacitated by such accident to the extent of being physically
21 incapable of complying with this section.

22 ~~((5))~~ (7) Any driver covered by the provisions of subsection
23 ~~((2))~~ (4) of this section failing to stop or to comply with any of
24 the requirements of subsection ~~((3))~~ (5) of this section under said
25 circumstances shall be guilty of a gross misdemeanor: PROVIDED, That
26 this provision shall not apply to any person injured or incapacitated
27 by such accident to the extent of being physically incapable of
28 complying herewith.

29 ~~((6))~~ (8) The license or permit to drive or any nonresident
30 privilege to drive of any person convicted under this section or any
31 local ordinance consisting of substantially the same language as this
32 section of failure to stop and give information or render aid following
33 an accident with any vehicle driven or attended by any person shall be
34 revoked by the department.

35 ~~((7))~~ (9) If none of the persons specified are in condition to
36 receive the information to which they otherwise would be entitled under
37 subsection ~~((3))~~ (5) of this section, and no police officer is
38 present, the driver of any vehicle involved in such accident after

1 fulfilling all other requirements of subsections (1) (~~(and (3))~~)
2 through (5) of this section insofar as possible on his or her part to
3 be performed, shall forthwith report such accident to the nearest
4 office of the duly authorized police authority and submit thereto the
5 information specified in subsection (~~(3)~~) (5) of this section.
