1 AN ACT Relating to naming state highway routes; and amending RCW  
2 47.17.645 and 47.17.650.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 47.17.645 and 1970 ex.s. c 51 s 130 are each amended  
5 to read as follows:

6 A state highway to be known as state route number 502, and  
7 designated as the Battle Ground highway, is established as follows:

8 Beginning at a junction with state route number 5 in the vicinity  
9 north of Vancouver, thence easterly to a junction with state route  
10 number 503 at Battle Ground.

11 **Sec. 2.** RCW 47.17.650 and 1991 c 342 s 35 are each amended to read  
12 as follows:

13 A state highway to be known as state route number 503 is  
14 established as follows:

15 Beginning at a junction with state route number 500 at Orchards,  
16 thence northerly to a junction with state route number 502 at Battle  
17 Ground, thence northerly to Amboy, thence northeasterly by way of  
18 Cougar to the Cowlitz-Skamania county line; also

1           Beginning at a junction with state route number 503 in the vicinity  
2 of Yale, thence westerly to a junction with state route number 5 in the  
3 vicinity of Woodland.

4           That portion of state route number 503 from the junction with state  
5 route number 500 at Orchards, thence northerly to a junction with state  
6 route number 502 at Battle Ground, thence northerly to Amboy is  
7 designated as the Lewisville highway.
