1 AN ACT Relating to breast cancer awareness special license plates;
2 amending RCW 46.16.725, 46.16.601, 46.16.745, and 46.16.316; reenacting
3 and amending RCW 46.16.313; and adding new sections to chapter 46.16
4 RCW.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 46.16 RCW
7 to read as follows:

8 (1) The department shall issue a special license plate displaying
9 a breast cancer awareness emblem that may be used in lieu of regular or
10 personalized license plates for vehicles required to display one or two
11 vehicle license plates, excluding vehicles registered under chapter
12 46.87 RCW, upon terms and conditions established by the department.

13 (2) The special license plate created under this section is exempt
14 from review by the special license plate review board and RCW 46.16.725
15 and 46.16.745, except as provided in this section.

2 c 42 s 3 are each reenacted and amended to read as follows:

3 (1) The department may establish a fee of no more than forty
4 dollars for each type of special license plates issued under RCW
5 46.16.301(1) (a), (b), or (c), as existing before amendment by section
6 5, chapter 291, Laws of 1997, in an amount calculated to offset the
7 cost of production of the special license plates and the administration
8 of this program. This fee is in addition to all other fees required to
9 register and license the vehicle for which the plates have been
10 requested. All such additional special license plate fees collected by
11 the department shall be deposited in the state treasury and credited to
12 the motor vehicle fund.

13 (2) In addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon
14 application and registration of a motor vehicle, the holder of a
15 collegiate license plate shall pay an initial fee of forty dollars.
16 The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed twelve dollars of
17 each fee collected under this subsection for administration and
18 collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall be
19 remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper
20 identifying detailed report. The state treasurer shall credit the
21 funds to the appropriate collegiate license plate fund as provided in
22 RCW 28B.10.890.

23 (3) In addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon
24 renewal of a motor vehicle registration, the holder of a collegiate
25 license plate shall pay a fee of thirty dollars. The department shall
26 deduct an amount not to exceed two dollars of each fee collected under
27 this subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by
28 it. The remaining proceeds shall be remitted to the custody of the
29 state treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. The state
30 treasurer shall credit the funds to the appropriate collegiate license
31 plate fund as provided in RCW 28B.10.890.

32 (4) In addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon
33 application and registration of a motor vehicle, the holder of a
34 special baseball stadium license plate shall pay an initial fee of
35 forty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed
36 twelve dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for
37 administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining
38 proceeds, minus the cost of plate production, shall be distributed to

1 a county for the purpose of paying the principal and interest payments
2 on bonds issued by the county to construct a baseball stadium, as
3 defined in RCW 82.14.0485, including reasonably necessary
4 preconstruction costs, while the taxes are being collected under RCW
5 82.14.360. After this date, the state treasurer shall credit the funds
6 to the state general fund.

7 (5) In addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon
8 renewal of a motor vehicle registration, the holder of a special
9 baseball stadium license plate shall pay a fee of thirty dollars. The
10 department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two dollars of each fee
11 collected under this subsection for administration and collection
12 expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall be distributed
13 to a county for the purpose of paying the principal and interest
14 payments on bonds issued by the county to construct a baseball stadium,
15 as defined in RCW 82.14.0485, including reasonably necessary
16 preconstruction costs, while the taxes are being collected under RCW
17 82.14.360. After this date, the state treasurer shall credit the funds
18 to the state general fund.

19 (6) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due on
20 January 1, 2005, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid
21 upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder of a
22 professional firefighters and paramedics license plate shall pay an
23 initial fee of forty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount
24 not to exceed twelve dollars of each fee collected under this
25 subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by it.
26 The remaining proceeds must be remitted to the custody of the state
27 treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. Under RCW
28 46.16.755, the state treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor
29 vehicle account until the department determines that the state has been
30 reimbursed for the cost of implementing the professional firefighters
31 and paramedics license plates. Upon the determination by the
32 department that the state has been reimbursed, the treasurer shall
33 credit the proceeds to the Washington State Council of Firefighters
34 benevolent fund established under RCW 46.16.30902.

35 (7) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on January
36 1, 2006, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon
37 renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of a professional
38 firefighters and paramedics license plate shall, upon application, pay

1 a fee of thirty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to
2 exceed two dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for
3 administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining
4 proceeds must be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a
5 proper identifying detailed report. Under RCW 46.16.755, the state
6 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until
7 the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the
8 cost of implementing the professional firefighters and paramedics
9 special license plate. Upon the determination by the department that
10 the state has been reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds
11 to the Washington State Council of Firefighters benevolent fund
12 established under RCW 46.16.30902.

13 (8) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due on
14 November 1, 2004, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid
15 upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder of a
16 "Helping Kids Speak" license plate shall pay an initial fee of forty
17 dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed twelve
18 dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration
19 and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds must be
20 remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper
21 identifying detailed report. Pursuant to RCW 46.16.755, the state
22 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until
23 the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the
24 cost of implementing the "Helping Kids Speak" special license plate.
25 Upon the determination by the department that the state has been
26 reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the "Helping
27 Kids Speak" account established under RCW 46.16.30904.

28 (9) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on November
29 1, 2005, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon
30 renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of a "Helping Kids Speak"
31 license plate shall, upon application, pay a fee of thirty dollars.
32 The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two dollars of each
33 fee collected under this subsection for administration and collection
34 expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds must be remitted to
35 the custody of the state treasurer with a proper identifying detailed
36 report. Pursuant to RCW 46.16.755, the state treasurer shall credit
37 the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until the department
38 determines that the state has been reimbursed for the cost of

1 implementing the "Helping Kids Speak" special license plate. Upon the
2 determination by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the
3 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the "Helping Kids Speak" account
4 established under RCW 46.16.30904.

5 (10) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due on
6 January 1, 2005, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid
7 upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder of a "law
8 enforcement memorial" license plate shall pay an initial fee of forty
9 dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed twelve
10 dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration
11 and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall
12 be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper
13 identifying detailed report. Pursuant to RCW 46.16.755, the state
14 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until
15 the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the
16 cost of implementing the law enforcement memorial special license
17 plate. Upon the determination by the department that the state has
18 been reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the law
19 enforcement memorial account established under RCW 46.16.30906.

20 (11) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on January
21 1, 2006, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon
22 renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of a "law enforcement
23 memorial" license plate shall, upon application, pay a fee of thirty
24 dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two
25 dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration
26 and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall
27 be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper
28 identifying detailed report. Pursuant to RCW 46.16.755, the state
29 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until
30 the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the
31 cost of implementing the law enforcement memorial special license
32 plate. Upon the determination by the department that the state has
33 been reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the law
34 enforcement memorial account established under RCW 46.16.30906.

35 (12)(a) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due
36 on or after January 1, 2006, in addition to all fees and taxes required
37 to be paid upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder
38 of a Washington's Wildlife collection license plate shall pay an

1 initial fee of forty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount
2 not to exceed twelve dollars of each fee collected under this
3 subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by it.
4 The remaining proceeds must be remitted to the custody of the state
5 treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. Under RCW
6 46.16.755, the state treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor
7 vehicle account until the department determines that the state has been
8 reimbursed for the cost of implementing the Washington's Wildlife
9 license plate collection. Upon determination by the department that
10 the state has been reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds
11 to the state wildlife account. Proceeds credited to the state wildlife
12 account from the sale of the Washington's Wildlife license plate
13 collection may be used only for the department of fish and wildlife's
14 game species management activities.

15 (b) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on or after
16 January 1, 2007, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid
17 upon renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of a Washington's
18 Wildlife collection license plate shall, upon application, pay a fee of
19 thirty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed
20 two dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for
21 administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining
22 proceeds must be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a
23 proper identifying detailed report. Under RCW 46.16.755, the state
24 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until
25 the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the
26 cost of implementing the Washington's Wildlife license plate
27 collection. Upon determination by the department that the state has
28 been reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the state
29 wildlife account. Proceeds credited to the state wildlife account from
30 the sale of the Washington's Wildlife license plate collection may be
31 used only for the department of fish and wildlife's game species
32 management activities.

33 (13)(a) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due
34 on or after January 1, 2006, in addition to all fees and taxes required
35 to be paid upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder
36 of a Washington state parks and recreation commission special license
37 plate shall pay an initial fee of forty dollars. The department shall
38 deduct an amount not to exceed twelve dollars of each fee collected

1 under this subsection for administration and collection expenses
2 incurred by it. The remaining proceeds must be remitted to the custody
3 of the state treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report.
4 Under RCW 46.16.755, the state treasurer shall credit the proceeds to
5 the motor vehicle account until the department determines that the
6 state has been reimbursed for the cost of implementing the Washington
7 state parks and recreation commission special license plate. Upon
8 determination by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the
9 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the state parks education and
10 enhancement account established in RCW 79A.05.059.

11 (b) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on or after
12 January 1, 2007, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid
13 upon renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of a Washington
14 state parks and recreation commission special license plate shall, upon
15 application, pay a fee of thirty dollars. The department shall deduct
16 an amount not to exceed two dollars of each fee collected under this
17 subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by it.
18 The remaining proceeds must be remitted to the custody of the state
19 treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. Under RCW
20 46.16.755, the state treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor
21 vehicle account until the department determines that the state has been
22 reimbursed for the cost of implementing the Washington state parks and
23 recreation commission special license plate. Upon determination by the
24 department that the state has been reimbursed, the treasurer shall
25 credit the proceeds to the state parks education and enhancement
26 account established in RCW 79A.05.059.

27 (14)(a) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due
28 on or after January 1, 2006, in addition to all fees and taxes required
29 to be paid upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder
30 of a "Washington Lighthouses" license plate shall pay an initial fee of
31 forty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed
32 twelve dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for
33 administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining
34 proceeds must be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a
35 proper identifying detailed report. Under RCW 46.16.755, the state
36 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until
37 the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the
38 cost of implementing the "Washington Lighthouses" license plate. Upon

1 determination by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the
2 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the lighthouse environmental
3 programs account established under RCW 46.16.30912.

4 (b) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on or after
5 January 1, 2007, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid
6 upon renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of a "Washington
7 Lighthouses" license plate shall, upon application, pay a fee of thirty
8 dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two
9 dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration
10 and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds must be
11 remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper
12 identifying detailed report. Under RCW 46.16.755, the state treasurer
13 shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until the
14 department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the cost
15 of implementing the "Washington Lighthouses" license plate. Upon
16 determination by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the
17 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the lighthouse environmental
18 programs account established under RCW 46.16.30912.

19 (15)(a) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due
20 on or after January 1, 2006, in addition to all fees and taxes required
21 to be paid upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder
22 of a "Keep Kids Safe" license plate shall pay an initial fee of forty-
23 five dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed
24 twelve dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for
25 administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining
26 proceeds shall be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with
27 a proper identifying report. Pursuant to RCW 46.16.755, the state
28 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until
29 the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the
30 cost of implementing the "Keep Kids Safe" license plate. Upon
31 determination by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the
32 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the children's trust fund
33 established under RCW 43.121.100.

34 (b) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on or after
35 January 1, 2007, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid
36 upon renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of a "Keep Kids
37 Safe" license plate shall, upon application, pay a fee of thirty
38 dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two

1 dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration
2 and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall
3 be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper
4 identifying report. Pursuant to RCW 46.16.755, the state treasurer
5 shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until the
6 department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the cost
7 of implementing the "Keep Kids Safe" license plate. Upon determination
8 by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the treasurer
9 shall credit the proceeds to the children's trust fund established
10 under RCW 43.121.100.

11 (16)(a) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due
12 on or after January 1, 2006, in addition to all fees and taxes required
13 to be paid upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder
14 of a "we love our pets" license plate shall pay an initial fee of forty
15 dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed twelve
16 dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administrative
17 and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall
18 be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper
19 identifying detailed report. Pursuant to RCW 46.16.755, the state
20 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until
21 the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the
22 cost of implementing the "we love our pets" license plate. Upon
23 determination by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the
24 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the we love our pets account
25 established under RCW 46.16.30915.

26 (b) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on or after
27 January 1, 2007, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid
28 upon renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of a "we love our
29 pets" license plate shall, upon application, pay a fee of thirty
30 dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two
31 dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration
32 and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall
33 be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper
34 identifying detailed report. Pursuant to RCW 46.16.755, the state
35 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until
36 the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the
37 cost of implementing the "we love our pets" license plate. Upon

1 determination by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the
2 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the we love our pets account
3 established under RCW 46.16.30915.

4 (17)(a) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due
5 on or after January 1, 2006, in addition to all fees and taxes required
6 to be paid upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder
7 of a "Gonzaga University alumni association" license plate shall pay an
8 initial fee of forty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount
9 not to exceed twelve dollars of each fee collected under this
10 subsection for administrative and collection expenses incurred by it.
11 The remaining proceeds shall be remitted to the custody of the state
12 treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. Pursuant to RCW
13 46.16.755, the state treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor
14 vehicle account until the department determines that the state has been
15 reimbursed for the cost of implementing the "Gonzaga University alumni
16 association" license plate. Upon determination by the department that
17 the state has been reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds
18 to the Gonzaga University alumni association account established under
19 RCW 46.16.30917.

20 (b) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on or after
21 January 1, 2007, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid
22 upon renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of a "Gonzaga
23 University alumni association" license plate shall, upon application,
24 pay a fee of thirty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not
25 to exceed two dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for
26 administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining
27 proceeds shall be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with
28 a proper identifying detailed report. Pursuant to RCW 46.16.755, the
29 state treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account
30 until the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for
31 the cost of implementing the "Gonzaga University alumni association"
32 license plate. Upon determination by the department that the state has
33 been reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the Gonzaga
34 University alumni association account established under RCW
35 46.16.30917.

36 (18) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due on
37 or after January 1, 2006, in addition to all fees and taxes required to
38 be paid upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder of

1 a "Washington's National Park Fund" license plate shall pay an initial
2 fee of forty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to
3 exceed twelve dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for
4 administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining
5 proceeds must be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a
6 proper identifying detailed report. Under RCW 46.16.755, the state
7 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until
8 the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the
9 cost of implementing the "Washington's National Park Fund" license
10 plate. Upon determination by the department that the state has been
11 reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the
12 "Washington's National Park Fund" account established under RCW
13 46.16.30919.

14 (19) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on or
15 after January 1, 2007, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be
16 paid upon renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of a
17 "Washington's National Park Fund" license plate shall, upon
18 application, pay a fee of thirty dollars. The department shall deduct
19 an amount not to exceed two dollars of each fee collected under this
20 subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by it.
21 The remaining proceeds must be remitted to the custody of the state
22 treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. Under RCW
23 46.16.755, the state treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor
24 vehicle account until the department determines that the state has been
25 reimbursed for the cost of implementing the "Washington's National Park
26 Fund" license plate. Upon determination by the department that the
27 state has been reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds to
28 the "Washington's National Park Fund" account established under RCW
29 46.16.30919.

30 (20)(a) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due
31 on or after January 1, 2006, in addition to all fees and taxes required
32 to be paid upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder
33 of an armed forces license plate shall pay an initial fee of forty
34 dollars. The department shall retain an amount not to exceed twelve
35 dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration
36 and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds must be
37 remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper
38 identifying report. Under RCW 46.16.755, the state treasurer shall

1 credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until the department
2 determines that the state has been reimbursed for the cost of
3 implementing the armed forces special license plate collection. Upon
4 determination by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the
5 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the veterans stewardship account
6 established under RCW 43.60A.140.

7 (b) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on or after
8 January 1, 2007, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid
9 upon renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of an armed forces
10 license plate shall, upon application, pay a fee of thirty dollars.
11 The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two dollars of each
12 fee collected under this subsection for administration and collection
13 expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds must be remitted to
14 the custody of the state treasurer with a proper identifying report.
15 Under RCW 46.16.755, the state treasurer shall credit the proceeds to
16 the motor vehicle account until the department determines that the
17 state has been reimbursed for the cost of implementing the armed forces
18 special license plate collection. Upon the determination by the
19 department that the state has been reimbursed, the treasurer shall
20 credit the proceeds to the veterans stewardship account established in
21 RCW 43.60A.140.

22 (21)(a) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due
23 on or after January 1, 2006, in addition to all fees and taxes required
24 to be paid upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder
25 of a "Ski & Ride Washington" license plate shall pay an initial fee of
26 forty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed
27 twelve dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for
28 administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining
29 proceeds must be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a
30 proper identifying detailed report. Under RCW 46.16.755, the state
31 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until
32 the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the
33 cost of implementing the "Ski & Ride Washington" license plate. Upon
34 determination by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the
35 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the "Ski & Ride Washington"
36 account established under RCW 46.16.30923.

6 remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper
7 identifying detailed report. Under RCW 46.16.755, the state treasurer

11 determination by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the

14 (22)(a) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due
15 on or after January 1, 2006, in addition to all fees and taxes required

17 of a Wild On Washington license plate shall pay an initial fee of forty
18 dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed twelve

21 remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper

16 forty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed
17 twelve dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for
18 administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining
19 proceeds must be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a
20 proper identifying detailed report. Under RCW 46.16.755, the state
21 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until

23 cost of implementing the Endangered Wildlife license plate. Upon

31 upon renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of an Endangered
32 Wildlife license plate shall, upon application, pay a fee of thirty
33 dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two
34 dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration
35 and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds must be
36 remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper
37 identifying detailed report. Under RCW 46.16.755, the state treasurer

11 of a "Share the Road" license plate shall pay an initial fee of forty
12 dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed twelve
13 dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration
14 and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds must be
15 remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper
16 identifying detailed report. Under RCW 46.16.755, the state treasurer
17 shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until the
18 department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the cost
19 of implementing the "Share the Road" license plate. Upon determination
20 by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the treasurer

5 forty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed
6 twelve dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for
7 administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining
8 proceeds must be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a
9 proper identifying detailed report. Under RCW 46.16.755, the state
10 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until
11 the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the

33 (1) The breast cancer awareness license plate account is created in
34 the custody of the state treasurer. Upon the department's
35 determination that the state has been reimbursed for the cost of
36 implementing the breast cancer awareness special license plate, all
37 receipts, except as provided in RCW 46.16.313(25) (a) and (b), from

1 breast cancer awareness license plates must be deposited into the

13 tax exempt status under section 501(c)(3) of the federal internal
14 revenue code (26 U.S.C. Sec. 501(c)(3)). The organization must promote
15 breast cancer awareness education in communities throughout Washington.

16 (c) The qualified nonprofit organization must meet all requirements
17 set out in RCW 46.16.765.

18 **Sec. 4.** RCW 46.16.725 and 2009 c 470 s 710 are each amended to
19 read as follows:

20 (1) The creation of the board does not in any way preclude the
21 authority of the legislature to independently propose and enact special
22 license plate legislation.

23 (2) The board must review and either approve or reject special
24 license plate applications submitted by sponsoring organizations.

25 (3) Duties of the board include but are not limited to the
26 following:

27 (a) Review and approve the annual financial reports submitted by
28 sponsoring organizations with active special license plate series and
29 present those annual financial reports to the senate and house
30 transportation committees;

8 (e) Provide policy guidance and directions to the department
9 concerning the adoption of rules necessary to limit the number of
10 special license plates that an organization or a governmental entity

14 plates, the legislature declares a temporary moratorium on the issuance
15 of any additional plates until July 1, 2011. During this period of

18 reviewing, processing, or approving any applications. Additionally, no
19 special license plate may be enacted by the legislature during the

33 (2) Personalized special plates issued under this section may be
34 personalized only by using numbers or letters, or any combination
35 thereof not exceeding seven positions, and not less than one position,
36 to the extent that there are no conflicts with existing license plate

1 series. A personalized special license plate is subject to the same
2 requirements as personalized license plates listed in RCW 46.16.575,
3 46.16.580, 46.16.590, 46.16.595, and 46.16.600.

4 (3) In addition to any other fees and taxes due at the time of
5 registration, applicants for a personalized special license plate must
6 pay both the fees to purchase and renew a special plate as set out in
7 the statute creating the special plate and the personalized plate as
8 required in RCW 46.16.585 and 46.16.606. The special plate fee must be
9 distributed in accordance with the requirements set out in the statute
10 creating the special plate. The personalized plate fee must be
11 distributed under RCW 46.16.605 and 46.16.606. The transfer of
12 personalized special plates is to be administered under RCW 46.16.316.

13 **Sec. 6.** RCW 46.16.745 and 2005 c 210 s 8 are each amended to read
14 as follows:

15 (1) A sponsoring organization meeting the requirements of RCW
16 46.16.735, applying for the creation of a special license plate to the
17 special license plate review board must, on an application supplied by
18 the department, provide the minimum application requirements in
19 subsection (2) of this section.

20 (2) The sponsoring organization shall:

21 (a) Submit prepayment of all start-up costs associated with the
22 creation and implementation of the special license plate in an amount
23 determined by the department. The department shall place this money
24 into the special license plate applicant trust account created under
25 RCW 46.16.755(~~(+4)~~) (3);

26 (b) Provide a proposed license plate design;

27 (c) Provide a marketing strategy outlining short and long-term
28 marketing plans for each special license plate and a financial analysis
29 outlining the anticipated revenue and the planned expenditures of the

16 (b) approved by the special license plate review board under RCW
17 46.16.715 through 46.16.775; or (c) under RCW 46.16.601 sells, trades,
18 or otherwise transfers or releases ownership of the vehicle upon which
19 the special license plate or plates have been displayed, he or she
20 shall immediately report the transfer of such plate or plates to an
