1 On page 93, after line 10, insert the following:

2 "Sec. 721. RCW 43.105.330 and 2006 c 76 s 2 are each amended to
3 read as follows:

4 (1) The board shall appoint a state interoperability executive
5 committee, the membership of which must include, but not be limited to,
6 representatives of the military department, the Washington state
7 patrol, the department of transportation, the department of information
8 services, the department of natural resources, city and county
9 governments, state and local fire chiefs, police chiefs, and sheriffs,
10 and state and local emergency management directors. The chair and
11 legislative members of the board will serve as nonvoting ex officio
12 members of the committee. Voting membership may not exceed fifteen
13 members.

14 (2) The chair of the board shall appoint the chair of the committee
15 from among the voting members of the committee.

16 (3) The state interoperability executive committee has the
17 following responsibilities:

18 (a) Develop policies and make recommendations to the board for
19 technical standards for state wireless radio communications systems,
20 including emergency communications systems. The standards must
21 address, among other things, the interoperability of systems, taking
22 into account both existing and future systems and technologies;

23 (b) Coordinate and manage on behalf of the board the licensing and
24 use of state-designated and state-licensed radio frequencies, including
25 the spectrum used for public safety and emergency communications, and
26 serve as the point of contact with the federal communications
27 commission on matters relating to allocation, use, and licensing of
28 radio spectrum;
