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EFFECT: The membership of the joint task force is increased from 11 members to 17 members, to include 12 legislators, the Superintendent of Public Instruction, and a representative of the School Directors' Association. The task force is given the added task of providing maximum transparency to parents, educators and other citizens regarding how the state's education system is funded and developing a mechanism that balances and shares funding responsibility between the local and state levels. The intent is amended to include reference to the McCleary Supreme Court decision in the rationale for creating the task force.

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
