- 1 On page 3, after line 20 of the amendment, insert the following:
- 2 "Sec. 4. RCW 77.12.177 and 2011 c 339 s 4 are each amended to read as follows:
  - (1) Except as provided in this title, state and county officers receiving the following moneys shall deposit them in the state general fund:
  - (a) Except as provided in subsection (7) of this section and for licenses issued under RCW 77.65.490, the sale of commercial licenses required under this title((, except for licenses issued under RCW 77.65.490)); and
    - (b) Moneys received for damages to food fish or shellfish.
- 12 (2) The director shall make weekly remittances to the state 13 treasurer of moneys collected by the department.
  - (3) All fines and forfeitures collected or assessed by a district court for a violation of this title or rule of the department shall be remitted as provided in chapter 3.62 RCW.
  - (4) Proceeds from the sale of food fish or shellfish taken in test fishing conducted by the department, to the extent that these proceeds exceed the estimates in the budget approved by the legislature, may be allocated as unanticipated receipts under RCW 43.79.270 to reimburse the department for unanticipated costs for test fishing operations in excess of the allowance in the budget approved by the legislature.
  - (5) Proceeds from the sale of salmon carcasses and salmon eggs from state general funded hatcheries by the department of ((general administration)) enterprise services shall be deposited in the regional fisheries enhancement group account established in RCW 77.95.090.
- 27 (6) Proceeds from the sale of herring spawn on kelp fishery 28 licenses by the department, to the extent those proceeds exceed 29 estimates in the budget approved by the legislature, may be allocated

- as unanticipated receipts under RCW 43.79.270. Allocations under this 1 2 subsection shall be made only for herring management, enhancement, and 3 enforcement.
  - (7)(a) The department must withhold two hundred fifty dollars from the sale of the following commercial salmon licenses and deposit the withholdings in the state wildlife account created in RCW 77.12.170:
    - (i) Salmon charter license issued under RCW 77.65.150(1)(b);
- (ii) Salmon gill net license issued under RCW 77.65.160; 8
- (iii) Salmon purse seine license issued under RCW 77.65.160; 9
- (iv) Salmon reef net license issued under RCW 77.65.160; and 10
- (v) Salmon troll license issued under RCW 77.65.160. 11

- (j) The department's share of revenues from auctions and raffles authorized by the commission;
- 5 (k) The sale of watchable wildlife decals under RCW 77.32.560; 6 ((and))
  - (1) Moneys received from the recreation access pass account created in RCW 79A.80.090 must be dedicated to stewardship, operations, and maintenance of department lands used for public recreation purposes; ((and))
- 11 (m) The portion of revenues generated through the sale of certain 12 commercial salmon licenses as set forth in RCW 77.12.177; and
  - (n) Donations received by the director under RCW 77.12.039.

<u>EFFECT:</u> Withholds \$250 of the revenue from certain commercial salmon license sold from the general fund and directs it to the state wildlife account for funding hatchery programs that produce salmon intended for commercial harvest.
