1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the
2 following:

3 "Sec. 1. RCW 28B.92.080 and 2009 c 238 s 9 are each amended to
4 read as follows:

5 Except for opportunity internship graduates whose eligibility is
6 provided under RCW 28B.92.084, for a student to be eligible for a state
7 need grant a student must:

8 (1) Be a "needy student" or "disadvantaged student" as determined
9 by the board in accordance with RCW 28B.92.030 (~~((+3))~~) (5) and (~~((+4))~~)
10 (2);

11 (2) Have been domiciled within the state of Washington for at least
12 one year;

13 (3) Be enrolled or accepted for enrollment on at least a half-time
14 basis at an institution of higher education in Washington as defined in
15 RCW 28B.92.030(~~((+1))~~) (4);

16 (4) Until June 30, (~~((2011))~~) 2013, to the extent funds are
17 specifically appropriated for this purpose, and subject to any terms
18 and conditions specified in the omnibus appropriations act, be enrolled
19 or accepted for enrollment for at least three quarter credits or the
20 equivalent semester credits at an institution of higher education in
21 Washington as defined in RCW 28B.92.030(~~((+1))~~) (4); and

22 (5) Have complied with all the rules adopted by the board for the
23 administration of this chapter.

24 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** (1) By December 1, 2012, the higher
25 education coordinating board, in collaboration with the state board for
26 community and technical colleges and institutions participating in
27 state need grants, shall report to the governor and the legislature
28 about the academic performance of less than half-time students awarded

1 need grants pursuant to RCW 28B.92.080(4). The report must include
2 data regarding:

3 (a) The total number of need grant recipients who enrolled on less
4 than a half-time basis for at least one academic quarter or semester;

5 (b) The length of time need grant recipients remained enrolled on
6 less than a half-time basis;

7 (c) The total number and proportion of need grant recipients who
8 subsequently enrolled on a full-time basis;

9 (d) The total number and proportion of need grant recipients who
10 subsequently received an academic degree or certificate compared to
11 full-time need grant recipients; and

12 (e) The total number of full-time and less than half-time need
13 grant recipients who were enrolled at four-year institutions and at a
14 community or technical college.

15 (2) The report must include an analysis and recommendations
16 regarding the continuation of the availability of state need grant
17 awards for less than half-time students taking into account the
18 academic achievement of less than half time as compared to less than
19 half-time need grant recipients and the overall limitations on state
20 need grant funding.

21 (3) This section expires December 31, 2012."

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22 On page 1, line 1 of the title, after "eligibility;" strike the
23 remainder of the title and insert "amending RCW 28B.92.080; creating a
24 new section; and providing an expiration date."

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
