

ESHB 2190 - S AMD TO S AMD (S-5295.1/12) **284**

1 On page 24, after line 35 of the amendment, insert the following:

2 "(5) The legislature recognizes that the trail known as the Apple
3 Capital Loop, and its extensions, serve to separate motor vehicle
4 traffic from pedestrians and bicyclists, increasing motor vehicle
5 safety on existing state route number 28. Consistent with chapter
6 47.30 RCW and pursuant to RCW 47.12.080, the legislature declares that
7 transferring portions of WSDOT Inventory Control (IC) Nos. 2-09-04537
8 and 2-09-04569 to Douglas county and the city of East Wenatchee is
9 consistent with the public interest. The legislature directs the
10 department to transfer the property to Douglas county and the city of
11 East Wenatchee. The department must be paid fair market value for any
12 portions of the transferred real property that is later abandoned,
13 vacated, or ceases to be publicly maintained for trail purposes.
14 Douglas county and the city of East Wenatchee must agree to accept
15 responsibility for trail segments within their respective jurisdictions
16 and sign an agreement with the state that the transfer of these parcels
17 to their respective jurisdictions extinguishes any state obligations to
18 improve, maintain, or be in any way responsible for these assets. The
19 department shall not surplus any of the lands adjoining the trail until
20 Douglas county and the city of East Wenatchee accomplish zoning and
21 land use planning as they deem necessary, provided those updates are
22 completed by January 1, 2014. The department shall report to the
23 transportation committees of the legislature by June 30, 2013, and
24 annually thereafter, on the status of the transfer until complete."

EFFECT: Adds language permitting the transfer of surplus property in Douglas county known as the Apple Capital Loop to the city of East

Wenatchee and Douglas county. Provides for terms and restrictions on the transfer.
