- 3 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 43.101 4 RCW to read as follows:
  - (1) The criminal justice training commission shall ensure that issues related to motorcycle profiling are addressed in basic law enforcement training and offered to in-service law enforcement officers in conjunction with existing training regarding profiling.
- 9 (2) Local law enforcement agencies shall add a statement condemning 10 motorcycle profiling to existing policies regarding profiling.
- 11 (3) For the purposes of this section, "motorcycle profiling" means 12 the illegal use of the fact that a person rides a motorcycle or wears 13 motorcycle-related paraphernalia as a factor in deciding to stop and 14 question, take enforcement action, arrest, or search a person or 15 vehicle with or without a legal basis under the United States 16 Constitution or Washington state Constitution."

- On page 1, line 1 of the title, after "profiling;" strike the remainder of the title and insert "and adding a new section to chapter 43.101 RCW."

**EFFECT:** (1) Removes the requirement that local law enforcement

agencies review and audit their existing procedures regarding the practice of motorcycle profiling.

- (2) Removes the requirement that local law enforcement agencies work with motorcycle groups in their communities to address the issue of motorcycle profiling.
- (3) Clarifies that motorcycle profiling training be addressed in the basic law enforcement academy training and in existing in-service training regarding profiling.
  - (4) Modifies the definition of motorcycle profiling.
