- 13 agency, may regulate the operation of nonhighway vehicles on public
- 14 lands, waters, and other properties under its jurisdiction, and on
- 15 streets, roads, or highways within its boundaries by adopting
- 16 regulations or ordinances of its governing body, provided such
- 17 regulations are not less stringent than the provisions of this chapter.

On page 1, line 1 of the title, after "Relating to" strike the remainder of the title and insert "authorizing the use of off-road vehicles on public roadways under certain conditions or in certain areas; amending RCW 46.09.360; adding a new section to chapter 46.09 RCW; prescribing penalties; and providing an effective date."

EFFECT: Allows the legislative body of a county with a population of no more than 5,000 persons to designate a street, road, or highway within its boundaries to be suitable for use by off-road vehicles and limits the annual vehicle license fee for two or four-wheel, all-terrain vehicles to \$30. Adds an effective date.
