1 On page 3, after line 2, insert the following:

2 "Sec. 2. RCW 46.09.360 and 2006 c 212 s 4 are each amended to read
3 as follows:

4 Notwithstanding any of the provisions of this chapter, any city,
5 county, or other political subdivision of this state, or any state
6 agency, may regulate the operation of nonhighway vehicles on public
7 lands, waters, and other properties under its jurisdiction, and on
8 streets, roads, or highways within its boundaries by adopting
9 regulations or ordinances of its governing body, provided such
10 regulations are not less stringent than the provisions of this chapter.
11 However, the legislative body of a city with a population of (~~less~~)
12 fewer than three thousand persons, or the legislative body of a county
13 with a population of no more than five thousand persons, may, by
14 ordinance, designate a street, road, or highway within its boundaries
15 to be suitable for use by off-road vehicles. The legislative body of
16 a county with a population of more than five thousand persons may, by
17 ordinance, designate a road or highway within its boundaries to be
18 suitable for use by off-road vehicles if the road or highway is a
19 direct connection between a city with a population of (~~less~~) fewer
20 than three thousand persons and an off-road vehicle recreation
21 facility."

22 On page 1, line 1 of the title, after "Relating to" strike the

1 remainder of the title and insert "authorizing the use of off-road
2 vehicles on public roadways under certain conditions or in certain
3 areas; amending RCW 46.09.360; adding a new section to chapter 46.09
4 RCW; and prescribing penalties."

EFFECT: Allows the legislative body of a county with a population of no more than 5,000 persons to designate a street, road, or highway within its boundaries to be suitable for use by off-road vehicles.
