ESHB 1175

As of Second Reading

Title: An act relating to transportation funding and appropriations.

Brief Description: Making transportation appropriations for the 2009-2011 and 2011-2013 fiscal biennia.

Sponsors: House Committee on Transportation (originally sponsored by Representatives Clibborn, Armstrong, Liias and Billig; by request of Governor Gregoire).

Brief History: Passed House: 3/25/11, 89-6.

Background: The operating and capital expenses of state transportation agencies and programs are funded on a biennial basis by an Omnibus Transportation Budget adopted by the Legislature in odd-numbered years.

Summary of Bill: Appropriations are made for state transportation agencies and programs for the 2011-13 fiscal biennium. Additionally, the 2009-11 biennial appropriations for various transportation agencies and programs are modified.
