- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 4.24 RCW 6 to read as follows:
 - privately operated correctional facility seeks leave to proceed in any legal action in any state court at public expense, the court shall deny the request and dismiss any action, appeal, or special proceeding, commenced by the person if that person has, on three or more prior occasions, while he or she was incarcerated, imprisoned, confined, or

If a person serving a criminal sentence in a state, local, or

- 14 facility, brought an appeal, legal action, or special proceeding that
- 15 was dismissed by a state or federal court on the grounds that it was
