1 AN ACT Relating to motorcycle profiling; and adding a new section
2 to chapter 43.101 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 43.101 RCW
5 to read as follows:

6 (1) The criminal justice training commission and the Washington
7 state patrol shall ensure that issues related to motorcycle profiling
8 are addressed in basic law enforcement training and offered to in-
9 service law enforcement officers in conjunction with existing training
10 regarding profiling.

11 (2) State and local law enforcement agencies shall add a statement
12 condemning motorcycle profiling to existing policies regarding
13 profiling.

14 (3) For the purposes of this section, "motorcycle profiling" means
15 using solely the fact that a person is riding a motorcycle or is
16 wearing certain motorcycle-related paraphernalia while riding a
17 motorcycle as a pretext in deciding whether or not to stop, detain,

1 question, search, or arrest a person operating a motorcycle.
