- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.18.200 and 2010 c 161 s 611 are each amended to 6 read as follows:
  - (1) ((The legislature recognizes that the special license plate review board established in RCW 46.16.705 reviews and approves applications for special license plate series.
- 10 (2))) Special license plate series reviewed and approved by the ((special license plate review board)) department:
- 12 (a) May be issued in lieu of standard issue or personalized license 13 plates for vehicles required to display one and two license plates 14 unless otherwise specified;
- 15 (b) Must be issued under terms and conditions established by the 16 department;
- 17 (c) Must not be issued for vehicles registered under chapter 46.87 18 RCW; and

NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 46.04 RCW to read as follows:

"In God We Trust license plates" means license plates issued under RCW 46.18.200 that display a symbol or artwork with the words "In God We Trust."

22 **Sec. 3.** RCW 46.17.220 and 2010 c 161 s 521 are each amended to 23 read as follows:

(1) In addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon application for a vehicle registration in chapter ((46.16)) 46.16A RCW, the holder of a special license plate shall pay the appropriate special license plate fee as listed in this section.

(2) After deducting administration and collection expenses for the sale of baseball stadium license plates, the remaining proceeds must be distributed to a county for the purpose of paying the principal and interest payments on bonds issued by the county to construct a baseball stadium, as defined in RCW 82.14.0485, including reasonably necessary

- preconstruction costs, while the taxes are being collected under RCW 82.14.360. After this date, the state treasurer shall credit the funds to the state general fund.
  - Sec. 4. RCW 46.68.425 and 2010 c 161 s 810 are each amended to read as follows:
    - (1) The department shall:
- 7 (a) Collect special license plate fees established under RCW 46.17.220 ((that were approved by the special license plate review 9 board under RCW 46.18.200));
  - (b) Deduct an amount not to exceed twelve dollars for initial issue and two dollars for renewal issue for administration and collection expenses incurred by it; and
  - (c) Remit the remaining proceeds to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report.
  - (2) The state treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle fund until the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the cost of implementing the special license plate. Upon determination by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the state treasurer shall credit the remaining special license plate tense plate fees to the following accounts by special license plate type:

- Sec. 5. RCW 43.60A.215 and 2010 c 90 s 2 are each amended to read as follows:
- (1) The disabled veterans assistance account is created in the custody of the state treasurer. Disbursements of funds must be on the authorization of the director or the director's designee, and only for the purposes stated in subsection (4) of this section. In order to maintain an effective expenditure and revenue control, funds are subject in all respects to chapter 43.88 RCW, but an appropriation is not required to permit the expenditure of the funds.
- (2) The department may request and accept nondedicated contributions, grants, or gifts in cash or otherwise, including funds generated by voluntary donations under RCW 43.60A.210 and the issuance of "In God We Trust" license plates under RCW 46.18.200.
- (3) All receipts from <u>(a)</u> voluntary donations under RCW 43.60A.210 and (b) except as provided in RCW 46.68.425(2), the sale of "In God We <u>Trust" license plates</u> must be deposited into the account.
- (4) All moneys deposited into the account must be used by the department for activities that benefit veterans including, but not limited to, providing programs and services that assist veterans with the procurement of durable medical equipment, mobility enhancing equipment, emergency home or vehicle repair, emergency food or emergency shelter, or service animals. The first priority for assistance provided through the account must be given to veterans who are experiencing a financial hardship and do not qualify for other federal or state veterans programs and services. Funds from the account may not be used to supplant existing funds received by the department.
- 31 (5) For the purposes of this section, "veteran" has the same 32 meaning as in RCW 41.04.005 and 41.04.007, and also means an actively 33 serving member of the national guard or reserves, or is active duty 34 military personnel.
