- AN ACT Relating to procedures for written business contracts; and adding a new chapter to Title 19 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The definitions in this section apply throughout this chapter unless the context clearly requires otherwise.
  - (1) "Authorized business representative" means a natural person authorized to conduct business on behalf of a business entity, including a limited liability company, corporation, or nonprofit corporation, registered in Washington or another state.
  - (2) "Business payment contract containing a personal guarantee" means a written agreement between two or more parties in which at least one party is an authorized business representative who, as consideration for the agreement, promises to guarantee the debt of a business entity.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. Any business payment contract containing a personal guarantee must contain the following for each authorized business representative who is a party to the agreement and who is making a personal guarantee:

- 1 (1) A separate signature line, directly following and on the same 2 page as any other signature line or lines that the authorized business 3 representative must sign to signal his or her acceptance of the 4 agreement;
  - (2) The signature line must be preceded directly on the same page by the phrase, "DISCLOSURE: By signing this contract you, the undersigned, are agreeing to PERSONALLY GUARANTEE payment according to the terms of this contract." The phrase must be written in bold, fourteen-point or larger font in clearly visible ink.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. The personal guarantee of an authorized business representative in a business payment contract containing a personal guarantee found not to meet the requirements of section 2 of this act is against the public policy of this state and is to that extent unenforceable.
- NEW SECTION. **Sec. 4.** This chapter applies to business payment contracts containing a personal guarantee executed on or after January 1, 2012.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 5. Sections 1 through 4 of this act constitute a new chapter in Title 19 RCW.
