- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 28B.92.080 and 2009 c 238 s 9 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
 - Except for opportunity internship graduates whose eligibility is provided under RCW 28B.92.084, for a student to be eligible for a state need grant a student must:
- 9 (1) Be a "needy student" or "disadvantaged student" as determined 10 by the board in accordance with RCW 28B.92.030 $((\frac{3}{3}))$ and $(\frac{4}{3})$ 11 (5);
- 12 (2) Have been domiciled within the state of Washington for at least one year;
- (3) Be enrolled or accepted for enrollment ((on at least a halftime basis)) for at least three quarter credits or the equivalent
 semester credits at an institution of higher education in Washington as
 defined in RCW 28B.92.030(((1))) (4); and
- 18 (4) ((Until June 30, 2011, to the extent funds are specifically 19 appropriated for this purpose, and subject to any terms and conditions
