1 AN ACT Relating to funding all-day kindergarten; adding a new
2 section to chapter 82.32 RCW; creating a new section; repealing RCW
3 82.08.0273; and providing an effective date.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that during difficult
6 fiscal times it must prioritize scarce resources so as to provide the
7 best outcomes for the citizenry of our state. Furthermore, the
8 Washington state Constitution finds that it is the paramount duty of
9 the state to fully and amply fund our public school system. Therefore,
10 the legislature intends to repeal the nonresident sales tax exemption
11 and direct the increased resources to K-12 public education.

12 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** RCW 82.08.0273 (Exemptions--Sales to
13 nonresidents of tangible personal property, digital goods, and digital
14 codes for use outside the state--Proof of nonresident status--
15 Penalties) and 2011 c 7 s 1, 2010 c 106 s 215, 2009 c 535 s 512, 2007
16 c 135 s 2, 2003 c 53 s 399, 1993 c 444 s 1, 1988 c 96 s 1, 1982 1st
17 ex.s. c 5 s 1, & 1980 c 37 s 39 are each repealed.

1 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 82.32 RCW
2 to read as follows:

3 By May 1, 2013, and by May 1st of every year thereafter, the
4 department must annually estimate the increase in state revenue for the
5 prior calendar year resulting from the repeal of RCW 82.08.0273 under
6 section 2, chapter . . ., Laws of 2012 (section 2 of this act) and
7 certify the estimated amount to the state treasurer. By July 1, 2013,
8 and by July 1st of every year thereafter, the state treasurer must
9 transfer the amount into the all-day kindergarten account hereby
10 created in the state treasury. Money in the account may only be used
11 to fund all-day kindergarten.

12 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 4.** This act takes effect July 1, 2012.
