- 2 machine at retail establishments; adding a new section to chapter
- 3 70.158 RCW; and adding a new section to chapter 70.155 RCW.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 70.158 RCW
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 For the purposes of this chapter and chapters 70.157 and 82.24 RCW,
- 8 every owner or retailer who maintains a machine at a retail
- 9 establishment that enables a person to process a product made or
- 10 derived from tobacco into a roll or tube shall be deemed to be a
- 11 manufacturer of cigarettes. The resulting product shall be deemed to
- 12 be a cigarette.
- 13 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 70.155 RCW
- 14 to read as follows:
- 15 A retailer may allow a person to process a product made or derived
- 16 from tobacco into a roll or tube by use of a machine. A retailer is
- 17 prohibited from permitting the use of the machine by a person:

- 1 (1) With tobacco, rolls, or tubes that are not purchased from that 2 retail establishment; or
- 3 (2) At a time that is not contemporaneous to the time of the purchase of the tobacco, rolls, or tubes.
