1 AN ACT Relating to exempting personal information relating to
2 children in licensed child care from public inspection and copying; and
3 reenacting and amending RCW 42.56.230.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 42.56.230 and 2011 c 350 s 2 and 2011 c 173 s 1 are
6 each reenacted and amended to read as follows:

7 The following personal information is exempt from public inspection
8 and copying under this chapter:

9 (1) Personal information in any files maintained for students in
10 public schools, patients or clients of public institutions or public
11 health agencies, or welfare recipients;

12 (2)(a) Personal information((7)) including, but not limited to,
13 addresses, telephone numbers, personal electronic mail addresses,
14 social security numbers, emergency contact and date of birth
15 information:

16 (i) Contained in any files or records relating to a child that are
17 maintained by a child care provider licensed by the department of early
18 learning; or

1 (ii) For a participant in a public or nonprofit program serving or
2 pertaining to children, adolescents, or students, including but not
3 limited to early learning or child care services, parks and recreation
4 programs, youth development programs, and after-school programs.

5 (b) Emergency contact information under this subsection (2) may be
6 provided to appropriate authorities and medical personnel for the
7 purpose of treating the individual during an emergency situation;

8 (3) Personal information in files maintained for employees,
9 appointees, or elected officials of any public agency to the extent
10 that disclosure would violate their right to privacy;

11 (4) Information required of any taxpayer in connection with the
12 assessment or collection of any tax if the disclosure of the
13 information to other persons would: (a) Be prohibited to such persons
14 by RCW 84.08.210, 82.32.330, 84.40.020, 84.40.340, or any ordinance
15 authorized under RCW 35.102.145; or (b) violate the taxpayer's right to
16 privacy or result in unfair competitive disadvantage to the taxpayer;

17 (5) Credit card numbers, debit card numbers, electronic check
18 numbers, card expiration dates, or bank or other financial account
19 numbers, except when disclosure is expressly required by or governed by
20 other law;

21 (6) Personal and financial information related to a small loan or
22 any system of authorizing a small loan in RCW 31.45.093; and

23 (7)(a) Documents and related materials and scanned images of
24 documents and related materials used to prove identity, age,
25 residential address, social security number, or other personal
26 information required to apply for a driver's license or identicard.

27 (b) Information provided under RCW 46.20.111 that indicates that an
28 applicant declined to register with the selective service system.

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
