1 WHEREAS, It is of paramount importance to establish cutoff dates
2 for the consideration of legislation during the 2012 Regular Session of
3 the Sixty-second Legislature;

4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the House of Representatives of
5 the State of Washington, the Senate concurring, That the following
6 cutoff dates apply to all bills, memorials, and joint resolutions with
7 the exception of budgets, matters necessary to implement budgets,
8 matters that affect state revenue, initiatives to the legislature, and
9 alternatives to initiatives to the legislature:

10 (1) Friday, February 3, 2012, the twenty-sixth day, will be the
11 final day to read in committee reports in the house of origin, with the
12 exception of reports from the Senate Ways and Means, Senate
13 Transportation, and House of Representatives fiscal committees;

14 (2) Tuesday, February 7, 2012, the thirtieth day, will be the final
15 day to read in Senate Ways and Means, Senate Transportation, and House
16 of Representatives fiscal committee reports in the house of origin;

17 (3) Tuesday, February 14, 2012, the thirty-seventh day, at 5:00
18 p.m., will be the final time to consider bills in their house of
19 origin;

1 (4) Friday, February 24, 2012, the forty-seventh day, will be the
2 final day to read in committee reports on bills from the opposite house
3 with the exception of reports from the Senate Ways and Means, Senate
4 Transportation, and House of Representatives fiscal committees;

5 (5) Monday, February 27, 2012, the fiftieth day, will be the final
6 day to read in Senate Ways and Means, Senate Transportation, and House
7 of Representatives fiscal committee reports on bills from the opposite
8 house; and

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That after 5:00 p.m. on Friday, March 2,
10 2012, the fifty-fourth day, neither house may consider any bills,
11 memorials, or joint resolutions except initiatives to the legislature
12 and alternatives to such initiatives, budgets and matters necessary to
13 implement budgets, matters that affect state revenue, messages
14 pertaining to amendments, matters of differences between the two
15 houses, and matters incident to the interim and to the closing of the
16 business of the 2012 Regular Session of the Legislature.
