1 AN ACT Relating to funding higher education child care grants; and
2 amending RCW 67.70.190, 28B.135.010, and 28B.135.040.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 67.70.190 and 2009 c 564 s 949 are each amended to
5 read as follows:

6 Unclaimed prizes shall be retained in the state lottery account for
7 the person entitled thereto for one hundred eighty days after the
8 drawing in which the prize is won, or after the official end of the
9 game for instant prizes. If no claim is made for the prize within this
10 time, all rights to the prize shall be extinguished, and the prize
11 shall be retained in the state lottery fund for further use as prizes,
12 except that one-third of all unclaimed prize money shall be deposited
13 in the economic development strategic reserve account created in RCW
14 43.330.250, and for each of fiscal years 2011-2012 and 2012-2013, two
15 hundred fifty thousand dollars shall be deposited in the student child
16 care in higher education account created in RCW 28B.135.010 to the
17 extent that these funds are provided in the omnibus appropriations act
18 and these amounts must be divided equally between the four-year and
19 two-year programs.

1 (~~On July 1, 2009, June 30, 2010, and June 30, 2011, all unclaimed~~
2 ~~prize money retained in the state lottery fund [account] in excess of~~
3 ~~three million dollars, excluding amounts distributed to the economic~~
4 ~~development strategic reserve account, shall be transferred into the~~
5 ~~state general fund.))~~

6 **Sec. 2.** RCW 28B.135.010 and 2010 1st sp.s. c 9 s 5 are each
7 amended to read as follows:

8 The (~~four-year~~) student child care in higher education account is
9 established. The higher education coordinating board shall administer
10 the program for the four-year institutions of higher education. The
11 state board for community and technical colleges shall administer the
12 program for the two-year institutions of higher education. Through
13 (~~these~~) this program(~~s~~) the board shall award either competitive or
14 matching child care grants to state institutions of higher education to
15 encourage programs to address the need for high quality, accessible,
16 and affordable child care for students at higher education
17 institutions. The grants shall be used exclusively for the provision
18 of quality child care services for students at institutions of higher
19 education. The university or college administration and student
20 government association, or its equivalent, of each institution
21 receiving the award may contribute financial support in an amount equal
22 to or greater than the child care grant received by the institution.

23 **Sec. 3.** RCW 28B.135.040 and 2010 1st sp.s. c 9 s 4 are each
24 amended to read as follows:

25 The (~~four-year~~) student child care in higher education account is
26 established in the custody of the state treasurer. Moneys in the
27 account may be spent only for the purposes of RCW 28B.135.010.
28 Disbursements from the account shall be on the authorization of the
29 higher education coordinating board or the state board for community
30 and technical colleges. The account is subject to the allotment
31 procedures under chapter 43.88 RCW, but no appropriation is required
32 for disbursements.

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
