1 AN ACT Relating to exempting vehicles owned and managed by the law  
2 enforcement bureau of the department of fish and wildlife from the  
3 state's motor vehicle transportation service; and amending RCW  
4 43.19.565.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6 **Sec. 1.** RCW 43.19.565 and 2011 1st sp.s. c 43 s 231 are each  
7 amended to read as follows:

8 The department shall establish a motor vehicle transportation  
9 service which is hereby empowered to:

10 (1) Provide suitable motor vehicle transportation services to state  
11 agencies on either a temporary or permanent basis and upon such  
12 demonstration of need as the department may require;

13 (2) Provide motor pools for the use of state agencies located in  
14 the Olympia area and such additional motor pools at other locations in  
15 the state as may be necessary to provide economic, efficient, and  
16 effective motor vehicle transportation services to state agencies.  
17 Such additional motor pools may be under either the direct control of  
18 the department or under the supervision of another state agency by  
19 agreement with the department;

1           (3) Establish an equitable schedule of rental and mileage charges  
2 to agencies for motor vehicle transportation services furnished which  
3 shall be designed to provide funds to recover the actual total costs of  
4 motor pool operations including but not limited to vehicle operation  
5 expense, depreciation expense, overhead, and nonrecoverable collision  
6 or other damage to vehicles; and

7           (4) Establish guidelines, procedures, and standards for fleet  
8 operations that other state agencies and institutions of higher  
9 education may adopt. The guidelines, procedures, and standards shall  
10 be consistent with and carry out the objectives of any general policies  
11 adopted by the office of financial management under RCW 43.41.130.

12           Unless otherwise determined by the director after consultation with  
13 the office of financial management, vehicles owned and managed by the  
14 department of transportation, the department of natural resources, the  
15 law enforcement bureau of the department of fish and wildlife, and the  
16 Washington state patrol are exempt from the requirements of subsections  
17 (1), (2), and (4) of this section.
