Implements by 2018 a redefined program of basic education and funding.

Builds on previous efforts by implementing funding formulas for the learning assistance program, transitional bilingual instruction, and pupil transportation.

Develops a realistic and practical implementation schedule for certain phased-in enhancements that, once fully implemented, will constitute the legislature's definition of basic education under Article IX of the state Constitution.
