- SB 6055 By Senators Eide, King, Hobbs, Haugen, Rolfes, Delvin, Fain, Shin and Conway  
Changing the expiration date of the current allowable vehicle documentary service charge.  
Referred to Committee on TRANSPORTATION.
- SB 6056 By Senators Swecker, Pridemore and Shin  
Concerning legal defense funds of candidates and public officials.  
Referred to Committee on GOVERNMENT OPERATIONS, TRIBAL RELATIONS & ELECTIONS.

Permitting recreation rock collecting, subject to certain restrictions.
