6 (a) A school sponsored equestrian team;
7 (b) A nonprofit career and technical student organization focused
8 on preparing students for careers in marketing, finance, hospitality,
9 and management;
10 (c) A nonprofit career and technical student organization focused
11 on promoting agricultural education; or
12 (d) A nonprofit career and technical student organization focused
13 on preparing students for careers in business and business-related
14 fields."

EFFECT: Allows allocations provided for the pilot project to be used to provide stipends for any other student at risk of dropout, if in the judgment of the district, the student's participation in certain activities promotes knowledge of farming and agriculture. These activities include a school sponsored equestrian team, a nonprofit career and technical student organization focused on preparing students for careers in marketing, finance, hospitality, and management, a nonprofit career and technical student organization focused on promoting agricultural education, or a nonprofit career and technical student organization focused on preparing students for careers in business and business-related fields.
