This requirement does not apply to appropriations for preconstruction activities or appropriations whose sole purpose is to purchase real property that does not include a construction or renovation component.
- (3) Projects funded in this section may be required to comply with Washington's high performance building standards as required by chapter 39.35D RCW.
- 14 (4) Project funds are available on a reimbursement basis only, and 15 shall not be advanced under any circumstances.
  - (5) Projects funded in this section must be held by the recipient for a minimum of ten years and used for the same purpose or purposes intended by the legislature as required in RCW 43.63A.125(6).

ACQUISITION OF PROPERTIES AND FACILITIES THROUGH FINANCIAL CONTRACTS. The following agencies may enter into financial contracts, paid from any funds of an agency, appropriated or nonappropriated, for the purposes indicated and in not more than the principal amounts 33 indicated, plus financing expenses and required reserves pursuant to 34 chapter 39.94 RCW. When securing properties under this section, agencies shall use the most economical financial contract option

available, including long-term leases, lease-purchase agreements, 1 2 lease-development with option to purchase agreements or financial contracts using certificates of participation. Expenditures made by an 3 agency for one of the indicated purposes before the issue date of the 4 authorized financial contract and any certificates of participation 5 therein are intended to be reimbursed from proceeds of the financial 6 contract and any certificates of participation therein to the extent 7 8 provided in the agency's financing plan approved by the state finance committee. 9

State agencies may enter into agreements with the department of enterprise services and the state treasurer's office to develop requests to the legislature for acquisition of properties and facilities through financial contracts. The agreements may include charges for services rendered.

Department of enterprise services: Enter into a financing contract for up to \$2,840,000 plus financing expenses and required reserves pursuant to chapter 39.94 RCW to purchase digital equipment.

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 7.** This act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect immediately."
