1 On page 47, after line 26, insert the following:

2 "Sec. 309. RCW 88.02.640 and 2013 c 291 s 1 are each amended to  
3 read as follows:

4 (1) In addition to any other fees and taxes required by law, the  
5 department, county auditor or other agent, or subagent appointed by the  
6 director shall charge the following vessel fees and surcharge:

4 (2) The five dollar dealer temporary permit fee required in  
5 subsection (1) of this section must be credited to the payment of  
6 registration fees at the time application for registration is made.

7 (3) The derelict vessel and invasive species removal fee required  
8 in subsection (1) of this section is five dollars and must be  
9 distributed as follows:

10 (a) One dollar and fifty cents must be deposited in the aquatic  
11 invasive species prevention account created in ((~~RCW 77.12.879~~))  
12 section 119 of this act;

13 (b) One dollar must be deposited into the aquatic algae control  
14 account created in RCW 43.21A.667;

15 (c) Fifty cents must be deposited into the aquatic invasive species  
16 enforcement account created in RCW 43.43.400; and

17 (d) Two dollars must be deposited in the derelict vessel removal  
18 account created in RCW 79.100.100.

19 (4) In addition to other fees required in this section, an annual  
20 derelict vessel removal surcharge of one dollar must be charged with  
21 each vessel registration. The surcharge is to address the significant  
22 backlog of derelict vessels accumulated in Washington waters that pose  
23 a threat to the health and safety of the people and to the environment  
24 and must be deposited into the derelict vessel removal account created  
25 in RCW 79.100.100.

26 (5) The twenty-five dollar nonresident vessel permit fee must be  
27 paid by the vessel owner to the department for the cost of providing  
28 the identification document by the department. Any moneys remaining  
29 from the fee after the payment of costs must be allocated to counties  
30 by the state treasurer for approved boating safety programs under RCW  
31 88.02.650.

32 (6) The thirty dollar vessel visitor permit fee must be distributed  
33 as follows:

34 (a) Five dollars must be deposited in the derelict vessel removal  
35 account created in RCW 79.100.100;

36 (b) The department may keep an amount to cover costs for providing  
37 the vessel visitor permit;

1 (c) Any moneys remaining must be allocated to counties by the state  
2 treasurer for approved boating safety programs under RCW 88.02.650; and

3 (d) Any fees required for licensing agents under RCW 46.17.005 are  
4 in addition to any other fee or tax due for the titling and  
5 registration of vessels.

6 (7)(a) The fifty dollar quick title service fee must be distributed  
7 as follows:

8 (i) If the fee is paid to the director, the fee must be deposited  
9 to the general fund.

10 (ii) If the fee is paid to the participating county auditor or  
11 other agent or subagent appointed by the director, twenty-five dollars  
12 must be deposited to the general fund. The remainder must be retained  
13 by the county treasurer in the same manner as other fees collected by  
14 the county auditor.

15 (b) For the purposes of this subsection, "quick title" has the same  
16 meaning as in RCW 88.02.540."

17 Renumber the remaining section consecutively, correct any internal  
18 references accordingly, and correct the title.

EFFECT: Corrects a reference to the aquatic invasive species prevention account.
