The following named officers and persons, active or retired, are 5 hereby authorized to solemnize marriages, to wit: Justices of the 6 supreme court, judges of the court of appeals, judges of the superior 7 8 courts, supreme court commissioners, court of appeals commissioners, 9 superior court commissioners, judges of courts of limited jurisdiction 10 as defined in RCW 3.02.010, judges of tribal courts from a federally recognized tribe, and any regularly licensed or ordained minister or 11 12 any priest, imam, rabbi, or similar official of any religious organization((, and judges of courts of limited jurisdiction as defined 13 That a marriage is solemnized by a duly appointed 14 in RCW 3.02.010)). tribal court judge from a federally recognized tribe pursuant to 15 16 authority under this section does not create tribal court jurisdiction 17 and does not affect state court authority as otherwise provided by law to enter a judgment for purposes of any dissolution, legal separation, 18 or other proceedings related to the marriage that is binding on the 19 20 parties and entitled to full faith and credit."

On page 1, line 1 of the title, after "marriages;" strike the remainder of the title and insert "and amending RCW 26.04.050." $\underline{\text{EFFECT:}}$ Specifies that tribal court judges from a federally recognized tribe may solemnize marriages.
