- (1) The capital vessel replacement account is created in the motor 5 6 All revenues generated from the vessel replacement surcharge under RCW 47.60.315(7) and service fees collected by the 7 department of licensing or county auditor or other agent appointed by 8
- 9 the director under RCW 46.17.040 must be deposited into the account.
- 10 Moneys in the account may be spent only after appropriation.
- 11 Expenditures from the account may be used only for the construction or
- 12 purchase of ferry vessels and to pay the principal and interest on

- However, expenditures from the account must first be used to support 14

with or without registration renewal, or for verification of record and
preparation of an affidavit of lost title other than at the time of the
certificate of title application or transfer; and

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- $((\frac{(2)}{(2)}))$ (b) Five dollars for a registration renewal, issuing a transit permit, or any other service under this section.
- 7 (2) Service fees collected under this section by the department or 8 county auditor or other agent appointed by the director must be credited to the capital vessel replacement account under RCW 47.60.322.
- 10 **Sec. 3.** RCW 46.17.050 and 2010 c 161 s 505 are each amended to 11 read as follows:

Before accepting a report of sale filed under RCW 46.12.650(2), the county auditor or other agent or subagent appointed by the director shall require the applicant to pay:

- 15 (1) The filing fee under RCW 46.17.005(1), the license plate 16 technology fee under RCW 46.17.015, and the license service fee under 17 RCW 46.17.025 to the county auditor or other agent; and
- 18 (2) The ((subagent)) service fee under RCW 46.17.040(((2))) (1)(b) 19 to the subagent.
- 20 **Sec. 4.** RCW 46.17.060 and 2010 c 161 s 507 are each amended to 21 read as follows:
- Before accepting a transitional ownership record filed under RCW 46.12.660, the county auditor or other agent or subagent appointed by the director shall require the applicant to pay:
- 25 (1) The filing fee under RCW 46.17.005(1), the license plate 26 technology fee under RCW 46.17.015, and the license service fee under 27 RCW 46.17.025 to the county auditor or other agent; and
- 28 (2) The ((subagent)) service fee under RCW 46.17.040(((2))) (1)(b) 29 to the subagent.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 5. This act applies to vehicle registrations that are due or become due on or after January 1, 2015, and certificate of title transactions that are processed on or after January 1, 2015."

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On page 1, line 1 of the title, after "replacement;" strike the 1 remainder of the title and insert "amending RCW 47.60.322, 46.17.040, 3 46.17.050, and 46.17.060; and creating a new section."

EFFECT: Removes the new fees that the department of licensing and county auditor or other agent appointed by the director are required to collect on vehicle registration and title transactions.

Authorizes the legislature to transfer excess funds in the capital vessel replacement account to the Puget Sound ferry operations account.

Requires the department of licensing and county auditor or other agent appointed by the director to collect the service fees collected by licensing subagents.

Makes technical reference corrections.

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
