1 Beginning on page 1, line 5, strike all of section 1

2 Renumber the remaining section consecutively.

3 On page 9, beginning on line 12, after "if" strike all material
4 through "felony" on line 17 and insert "(i) the present felony
5 conviction for which the person is being sentenced is for residential
6 burglary, burglary in the second degree, theft in the first degree,
7 theft in the second degree, or theft of a firearm; (ii) the person has
8 an offender score of nine points or higher; and (iii) at least nine of
9 the points in the person's offender score result from any combination
10 of the following felony offenses: Residential burglary, burglary in
11 the second degree, theft in the first degree, theft in the second
12 degree, or theft of a firearm:

13 (A) Twenty-four months if the offender is being sentenced for a
14 felony defined as a class B felony;

15 (B) Twelve months if the offender is being sentenced for a felony
16 defined as a class C felony"

17 On page 1, beginning on line 2 of the title, after "9.94A.533;"
18 strike all material through "RCW;" on line 3

EFFECT: Removes the special allegation making habitual property

offenders subject to sentencing enhancement. Automatically applies enhancement when person meets definition of a "habitual property offender." Limits felonies which would make a person subject to sentencing enhancement.
