

**SB 6010 - S AMD 511**

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the  
2 following:

3 "Sec. 1. RCW 9A.52.060 and 2011 c 336 s 371 are each amended to  
4 read as follows:

5 (1) Every person who shall make or mend or cause to be made or  
6 mended, or have in his or her possession, any engine, machine, tool,  
7 false key, pick lock, bit, nippers, up to ten altered or shaved keys,  
8 or implement adapted, designed, or commonly used for the commission of  
9 burglary under circumstances evincing an intent to use or employ, or  
10 allow the same to be used or employed in the commission of a burglary,  
11 or knowing that the same is intended to be so used, shall be guilty of  
12 making or having burglar tools.

13 (2) Making or having burglar tools is a gross misdemeanor.

14 **Sec. 2.** RCW 9A.56.063 and 2007 c 199 s 18 are each amended to read  
15 as follows:

16 (1) Any person who makes or mends, or causes to be made or mended,  
17 uses, or has in his or her possession any motor vehicle theft tool,  
18 that is adapted, designed, or commonly used for the commission of motor  
19 vehicle related theft, under circumstances evincing an intent to use or  
20 employ, or allow the same to be used or employed, in the commission of  
21 motor vehicle theft, or knowing that the same is intended to be so  
22 used, is guilty of making or having motor vehicle theft tools.

23 (2) For the purpose of this section, motor vehicle theft tool  
24 includes, but is not limited to, the following: Slim jim, false master  
25 key, master purpose key, up to ten altered or shaved keys, trial or  
26 jiggle key, slide hammer, lock puller, picklock, bit, nipper, any  
27 other implement shown by facts and circumstances that is intended to be  
28 used in the commission of a motor vehicle related theft, or knowing  
29 that the same is intended to be so used.

1 (3) For the purposes of this section, the following definitions  
2 apply:

3 (a) "False master" or "master key" is any key or other device made  
4 or altered to fit locks or ignitions of multiple vehicles, or vehicles  
5 other than that for which the key was originally manufactured.

6 (b) "Altered or shaved key" is any key so altered, by cutting,  
7 filing, or other means, to fit multiple vehicles or vehicles other than  
8 the vehicles for which the key was originally manufactured.

9 (c) "Trial keys" or "jiggler keys" are keys or sets designed or  
10 altered to manipulate a vehicle locking mechanism other than the lock  
11 for which the key was originally manufactured.

12 (4) Making or having motor vehicle theft tools is a gross  
13 misdemeanor."

14 On page 1, line 1 of the title, after "keys;" strike the remainder  
15 of the title and insert "amending RCW 9A.52.060 and 9A.56.063; and  
16 prescribing penalties."

EFFECT: Amends the crime of making or having burglar tools to include persons who make, mend, or have in their possession up to ten altered or shaved keys under circumstances evincing an intent to use or employ, or allow the same to be used or employed in the commission of a burglary, or knowing that the same is intended to be so used.
