- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 69.50 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 Upon finding one ounce or less of marijuana inadvertently left at
- 8 a retail store holding a pharmacy license, the store manager or
- 9 employee must promptly notify the local law enforcement agency or the
- 10 Washington state patrol. After notification to the local law
- 11 enforcement agency or the Washington state patrol, the store manager or
- 12 employee must properly dispose of the marijuana.
