AN ACT Relating to appropriations specifically for activities related to the aerospace industry for permitting and training, including program development, staff, facilities, and equipment; adding new sections to 2013 2nd sp.s. c 4 (uncodified); adding new sections to 2013 2nd sp.s. c 19 (uncodified); making appropriations; and declaring an emergency.

- 4 (2) \$500,000 of the general fund--state appropriation for fiscal year 2015 is provided solely for developing a fabrication composite wing incumbent worker training program to be housed at the Washington 7 aerospace training and research center. It is the intent of the legislature for development and planning funds to continue in fiscal year 2016 and for the training program to serve incumbent workers 10 starting with the 2015-16 academic year.
