- AN ACT Relating to cosmetology training and licensure requirements;
- 2 and amending RCW 18.16.090.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 18.16.090 and 2003 c 400 s 4 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- Examinations for licensure under this chapter shall be conducted at such times and places as the director determines appropriate.
- 8 Examinations shall consist of tests designed to reasonably measure the
- 9 applicant's knowledge of safe and sanitary practices and may also
- 10 include the applicant's knowledge of this chapter and rules adopted
- 11 pursuant to this chapter. The director may establish by rule a
- 12 performance examination in addition to any other examination. The
- 13 director shall establish by rule the minimum passing score for all
- 14 examinations and the requirements for reexamination of applicants who
- 15 fail the examination or examinations. The director may allow an
- independent person to conduct the examinations at the expense of the
- 17 applicants.
- 18 The director shall take steps to ensure ((that after completion of
- 19 the required course or apprenticeship program,)) applicants may

promptly take the examination ((and)) before completion of the required 1 training hours described in RCW 18.16.020 if all other school or 2 apprenticeship program requirements are met, or after completion of an 3 approved curriculum. The director shall also take steps to ensure 4 applicants may promptly receive the results of the examination. 5 The 6 director shall not issue a license until the applicant has completed 7 all the required training hours, the school or apprenticeship program has verified these hours, and the applicant has met all requirements of 8 9 RCW 18.16.100.
