1 AN ACT Relating to the criminal justice training commission firing
2 range maintenance account; and adding a new section to chapter 43.101
3 RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 43.101 RCW
6 to read as follows:

7 The criminal justice training commission firing range maintenance
8 account is created in the custody of the state treasurer. All moneys
9 generated by the rental of the commission's firing range facilities,
10 property, and equipment must be deposited into the account. The
11 sources of the moneys generated and deposited under this section may
12 include federal, state, local, or private grants, consistent with RCW
13 43.101.190. Expenditures from the account may be used only for cost
14 related to rental, maintenance, or development of the commission's
15 firing range facilities, property, and equipment. Only the executive
16 director, acting on behalf of the criminal justice training commission,
17 or the executive director's designee may authorize expenditures from
18 the account. The account is subject to allotment procedures under

1 chapter 43.88 RCW, but an appropriation is not required for
2 expenditures.

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
