1 AN ACT Relating to state need grant eligibility; amending RCW
2 28B.92.080; creating a new section; and providing an expiration date.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 28B.92.080 and 2012 c 229 s 605 are each amended to
5 read as follows:

6 Except for opportunity internship graduates whose eligibility is
7 provided under RCW 28B.92.084, for a student to be eligible for a state
8 need grant a student must:

9 (1) Be a "needy student" or "disadvantaged student" as determined
10 by the office in accordance with RCW 28B.92.030 (~~((+1))~~) (2) and (~~((+4))~~)
11 (5);

12 (2) Have been domiciled within the state of Washington for at least
13 one year;

14 (3) Be enrolled or accepted for enrollment on at least a half-time
15 basis at an institution of higher education in Washington as defined in
16 RCW 28B.92.030(~~((+3))~~) (4);

17 (4) Until June 30, (~~(2011, to the extent funds are specifically~~
18 ~~appropriated for this purpose, and subject to any terms and conditions~~
19 ~~specified in the omnibus appropriations act)) 2015, be enrolled or~~

1 accepted for enrollment for at least three quarter credits or the
2 equivalent semester credits at an institution of higher education in
3 Washington as defined in RCW 28B.92.030(~~(+3+)~~) (4); and

4 (5) Have complied with all the rules adopted by the council for the
5 administration of this chapter.

6 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** (1) The student achievement council shall
7 report to the legislature by December 1, 2013, regarding the number of
8 students enrolled in three to five credit-bearing quarter credits, or
9 the equivalent semester credits, and their academic progress including
10 degree completion.

11 (2) This section expires December 31, 2013.
