- RCW 9A.36.011 and 1997 c 196 s 1 are each amended to read 6 Sec. 1. 7 as follows:
 - (1) A person is guilty of assault in the first degree if he or $she((\tau))$:
- 10 (a) With intent to inflict great bodily harm:
- 11 $((\frac{a}{a}))$ (i) Assaults another with a firearm or any deadly weapon or by any force or means likely to produce great bodily harm or death; or 12
- $((\frac{b}{b}))$ (ii) Administers, exposes, or transmits to or causes to be 14 taken by another, poison, the human immunodeficiency virus as defined 15 in chapter 70.24 RCW, or any other destructive or noxious substance; or
 - (((c))) (iii) Assaults another and inflicts great bodily harm; or
- (b) Assaults, with a deadly weapon, a corrections officer, law 17
- enforcement officer, community corrections officer, or an employee 18
