1 AN ACT Relating to making the board of denturists the disciplining
2 authority for licensed denturists; amending RCW 18.30.030, 18.30.065,
3 18.30.090, 18.30.095, 18.30.130, and 18.30.135; reenacting and amending
4 RCW 18.130.040 and 18.130.040; providing an effective date; and
5 providing an expiration date.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

7 **Sec. 1.** RCW 18.30.030 and 1995 c 1 s 4 are each amended to read as
8 follows:

9 No person may represent himself or herself as a licensed denturist
10 or use any title or description of services without applying for
11 licensure, meeting the required qualifications, and being licensed as
12 a denturist by the ((department)) board, unless otherwise exempted by
13 this chapter.

14 **Sec. 2.** RCW 18.30.065 and 2002 c 160 s 5 are each amended to read
15 as follows:

16 The board shall:

17 (1) Determine the qualifications of persons applying for licensure
18 under this chapter;

1 (2) Prescribe, administer, and determine the requirements for
2 examinations under this chapter and establish a passing grade for
3 licensure under this chapter;

4 (3) Adopt rules under chapter 34.05 RCW to carry out the provisions
5 of this chapter (~~in consultation and in agreement with the~~
6 ~~secretary~~);

7 (4) Have authority to provide requirements for continuing
8 competency as a condition of license renewal by rule (~~in agreement~~
9 ~~with the secretary~~); and

10 (5) Evaluate and approve those schools from which graduation is
11 accepted as proof of an applicant's completion of coursework
12 requirements for licensure.

13 **Sec. 3.** RCW 18.30.090 and 2002 c 160 s 6 are each amended to read
14 as follows:

15 The (~~secretary~~) board shall issue a license to practice denturism
16 to an applicant who submits a completed application, pays the
17 appropriate fees, and meets the following requirements:

18 (1) A person currently licensed to practice denturism under
19 statutory provisions of another state, territory of the United States,
20 District of Columbia, or Puerto Rico, with substantially equivalent
21 licensing standards to this chapter shall be licensed without
22 examination upon providing the (~~department~~) board with the following:

23 (a) Proof of successfully passing a written and clinical
24 examination for denturism in a state, territory of the United States,
25 District of Columbia, or Puerto Rico, that the board has determined has
26 substantially equivalent licensing standards as those in this chapter,
27 including but not limited to both the written and clinical
28 examinations; and

29 (b) An affidavit from the licensing agency where the person is
30 licensed or certified attesting to the fact of the person's licensure
31 or certification.

32 (2) A person graduating from a formal denturism program shall be
33 licensed if he or she:

34 (a) Documents successful completion of formal training with a major
35 course of study in denturism of not less than two years in duration at
36 an educational institution approved by the board; and

1 (b) Passes a written and clinical examination approved by the
2 board.

3 **Sec. 4.** RCW 18.30.095 and 2011 c 32 s 1 are each amended to read
4 as follows:

5 An applicant with military training or experience satisfies the
6 training or experience requirements of this chapter unless the
7 ((secretary)) board determines that the military training or experience
8 is not substantially equivalent to the standards of the state.

9 **Sec. 5.** RCW 18.30.130 and 1996 c 191 s 13 are each amended to read

11 The ((secretary)) board shall establish by rule the requirements
12 for renewal of licenses to practice denturism, but shall not increase
13 the licensure requirements provided in this chapter. The secretary
14 shall establish administrative procedures, administrative requirements,
15 and fees for license periods and renewals as provided in RCW 43.70.250
16 and 43.70.280.

17 **Sec. 6.** RCW 18.30.135 and 1995 c 336 s 3 are each amended to read

19 The Uniform Disciplinary Act, chapter 18.130 RCW, shall govern the
20 issuance and denial of licenses, unauthorized practice, and the
21 discipline of persons licensed under this chapter. The ((secretary))
22 board shall be the disciplinary authority under this chapter.
