- of the WorkFirst program; and amending RCW 74.08A.250.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 Sec. 1. RCW 74.08A.250 and 2011 1st sp.s. c 42 s 8 are each 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 Unless the context clearly requires otherwise, as used in this 7 chapter, "work activity" means:
 - (1) Unsubsidized paid employment in the private or public sector;
 - (2) Subsidized paid employment in the private or public sector, including employment through the state or federal work-study program for a period not to exceed twenty-four months;
 - (3) Work experience, including:

- 13 (a) An internship or practicum, that is paid or unpaid and is 14 required to complete a course of vocational training or to obtain a 15 license or certificate in a high-demand occupation, as determined by 16 the employment security department. No internship or practicum shall 17 exceed twelve months; or
- 18 (b) Work associated with the refurbishing of publicly assisted 19 housing, if sufficient paid employment is not available;

- (5) Job search and job readiness assistance;
- 3 (6) Community service programs, including a recipient's voluntary 4 service at a child care or preschool facility licensed under chapter 5 43.215 RCW or an elementary school in which his or her child is 6 enrolled;
 - (7) Vocational educational training, not to exceed ((twelve)) twenty-four months with respect to any individual;
 - (8) Job skills training directly related to employment;
 - (9) Education directly related to employment, in the case of a recipient who has not received a high school diploma or a GED;
 - (10) Satisfactory attendance at secondary school or in a course of study leading to a GED, in the case of a recipient who has not completed secondary school or received such a certificate;
- 15 (11) The provision of child care services to an individual who is 16 participating in a community service program;
 - (12) Internships, that shall be paid or unpaid work experience performed by an intern in a business, industry, or government or nongovernmental agency setting;
 - (13) Practicums, which include any educational program in which a student is working under the close supervision of a professional in an agency, clinic, or other professional practice setting for purposes of advancing their skills and knowledge;
- 24 (14) Services required by the recipient under RCW 74.08.025(3) and 74.08A.010(4) to become employable;
 - (15) Financial literacy activities designed to be effective in assisting a recipient in becoming self-sufficient and financially stable; and
- 29 (16) Parent education services or programs that support development 30 of appropriate parenting skills, life skills, and employment-related 31 competencies.
