1 AN ACT Relating to allowing multiple liquor licenses at the same
2 physical premises; and adding a new section to chapter 66.24 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 66.24 RCW
5 to read as follows:

6 (1) If a licensee complies with the provisions of RCW 66.28.280,
7 66.28.285, 66.28.290, 66.28.295, 66.28.300, 66.28.305, 66.28.310, and
8 66.28.315, nothing in this title prohibits any number or combination of
9 licenses or approvals from being issued or approved for the same
10 premises, overlapping premises, adjacent premises, or separate premises
11 to the same licensee or to different licensees under common ownership.

12 (2) Nothing in this section prohibits different licensees from
13 allocating distinct parts of a single business location to their
14 separate licenses.
