- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 26.44 RCW 6 to read as follows:
 - (1) If child protective services has knowledge of substantiated abuse or neglect, not mere allegations of child abuse or neglect, child protective services shall contact the public school district where the child is enrolled and share the information related to the abuse or neglect with the school district's superintendent or the superintendent's designee.
- (2) Each school district shall have a designated point of contact where child protective services can share substantiated concerns of child abuse or neglect with the school district superintendent or the superintendent's designee.
- 17 (3) Information provided to public school districts on 18 substantiated child abuse or neglect must remain confidential and may
