2 hospital district officials; and amending RCW 42.17A.705.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 42.17A.705 and 2012 c 229 s 582 are each amended to
5 read as follows:

34 authority, Washington energy northwest executive board, The Evergreen
35 State College board of trustees, executive ethics board, fish and
36 wildlife commission, forest practices appeals board, forest practices
37 board, gambling commission, Washington health care facilities
38 authority, student achievement council, higher education facilities

1 authority, horse racing commission, state housing finance commission,
2 human rights commission, indeterminate sentence review board, board of
3 industrial insurance appeals, state investment board, commission on
4 judicial conduct, legislative ethics board, life sciences discovery
5 fund authority board of trustees, liquor control board, lottery
