1 AN ACT Relating to creating flexibility for the educator retooling
2 conditional scholarship program; and amending RCW 28A.660.045.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 28A.660.045 and 2007 c 396 s 7 are each amended to
5 read as follows:

6 (1) The educator retooling (~~((to teach mathematics and science))~~)
7 conditional scholarship program is created. Participation is limited
8 to current K-12 teachers and individuals having an elementary education
9 certificate but who are not employed in positions requiring an
10 elementary education certificate. It is anticipated that candidates
11 enrolled in this program will complete the requirements for a
12 mathematics ((~~or~~)), science, special education, bilingual education, or
13 English language learner endorsement(~~((, or both,))~~) in two years or
14 less.

15 (2) Entry requirements for candidates include:

16 (a) Current K-12 teachers shall pursue a middle level mathematics
17 or science, (~~((or))~~) secondary mathematics or science, special education,
18 bilingual education, or English language learner endorsement.

1 (b) Individuals having an elementary education certificate but who
2 are not employed in positions requiring an elementary education
3 certificate shall pursue an endorsement only in middle level
4 mathematics or science (~~only~~), special education, bilingual
5 education, or English language learner.
