

HB 2080 - DIGEST

(SUBSTITUTED FOR - SEE 1ST SUB)

Allows persons convicted before January 1, 1975, of violating certain statutes or rules regarding the regulation of fishing activities, who claimed to be exercising a treaty Indian fishing right, to apply to the sentencing court for vacation of his or her record of the misdemeanor, gross misdemeanor, or felony conviction for the offense.
