1 On page 2, line 32, after "(4)" insert "If a biometric identifier
2 was initially captured for any purpose other than a commercial purpose,
3 it is a violation of this act to use the biometric identifier at a later
4 time for a commercial purpose without an individual's consent.

5 (5) For the purpose of subsection (4) of this section, consent
6 means that an individual must actively opt-in to the use of the
7 biometric identifier. An active opt-in by an individual provides
8 consent for the use of the biometric identifier for no longer than
9 24 hours.

10 (6)"

12 Renumber the remaining subsection consecutively and correct any
13 internal references accordingly.

EFFECT: Requires consent, defined as an active opt-in lasting
for a period of no more than 24 hours, from an individual to use
their biometric identifier for a commercial purpose when the
biometric identifier was initially captured for another purpose.
