1 On page 1, beginning on line 4 of the striking amendment, strike
2 all of section 1

3
4 Renumber the remaining sections consecutively and correct any
5 internal references accordingly.

7 On page 3, line 8 of the striking amendment, after "chapter"
8 strike "49.60" and insert "43.10"

9
10 On page 3, line 10 of the striking amendment, after "(1)" strike
11 all material through "it" and insert "It"

12
13 On page 5, after line 3 of the striking amendment, insert the
14 following:

15 "(6) The attorney general shall investigate complaints and
16 enforce this section. In addition to the complaint process with the
17 attorney general, any person deeming himself or herself injured by
18 any act in violation of this section shall have a civil cause of
19 action in court to enjoin further violations, or to recover the
20 actual damages sustained by the person, or both, together with the
21 cost of suit including reasonable attorneys' fees or any other
22 appropriate remedy authorized by state or federal law."

24 On page 5, beginning on line 5 of the striking amendment, strike
25 all of section 3

26
27 Correct the title.

EFFECT: (1) Removes the reasonable accommodation requirements from the Human Rights Commission statutes and places it in the Attorney General's Office statutes; (2) Requires the AG to investigate complaints and enforce the provisions; (3) Provides for a civil cause of action to enjoin further violations and to recover actual damages plus costs and reasonable attorneys' fees or any other appropriate remedy authorized by state or federal law.
