1 On page 15, after line 4, insert the following:

2 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 13.** A new section is added to chapter 28B.50
3 RCW to read as follows:

4 (1) The legislature finds that transparency in community and
5 technical college budgeting is essential to maintaining public trust
6 in the community and technical college system. The legislature
7 intends to require all nonappropriated local funds and corresponding
8 fund balances to be posted on the colleges' web sites.

9 (2) Within thirty days of adopting their annual college budgets,
10 each community and technical college district shall post on its web
11 site the budgeted and nonbudgeted revenues and anticipated
12 expenditures for all nonstate, nonappropriated funds including, but
13 not limited to, revenue from tuition, parking, rentals, parking lot
14 fees, bookstore sales, contract revenues such as international
15 student fees, running start revenue, and all other nonappropriated
16 accounts.

17 (3) Annually, within thirty days after fiscal closing, each
18 community and technical college shall post on its web site the
19 actual revenues and expenditures for all nonstate, non-appropriated
20 funds the ending fund balances for all nonstate, nonappropriated
21 funds and accounts from the previous fiscal year. These balances
22 must be reported as ending fund balances from the recently closed
23 fiscal year and the projected beginning fund balances for the
24 upcoming year where there is a difference between ending balance and
25 beginning fund balance due to transfers of funds between accounts.
26 The office of the state treasurer and the office of financial
27 management are strongly encouraged to make all relevant data

1 available to each community and technical college to ensure timely
2 posting of the relevant information to the college web sites."

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4 Correct the title.

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EFFECT: Requires each community and technical college district to post budgeted and non-budgeted revenues and anticipated expenditures for all non-state, nonappropriated funds to their websites within 30 days of adopting their annual college budgets. Requires each community and technical college to post ending fund balances for all non-state, non-appropriated funds and accounts from the previous fiscal year on their websites each year within 30 days after fiscal closing.

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
